### **Buckthorn Removal Project Event at Tower Hill Park**

The Prospect Park Garden Club and PPA's Tower Hill and Environment Committees, in cooperation with the Surly Gives-a-Damn volunteers, invited folks to take part in another BUCKTHORN CLEAN-UP day at Tower Hill Park, Saturday, June 28, 10 to noon. This is part of a projected 3-year project to eradicate buckthorn from Tower Hill and to replace it with native perennials, shrubs and trees.

## Volunteers Use "Critical Cutting" Method to Remove Invasive Buckthorn from Tower Hill Park




With the guidance of the Minneapolis Park District, volunteers came together throughout the summer and fall to clip and haul the invasive species using a pesticide free method called "Critical Cutting," which slowly kills the plant without damaging the landscape or poisoning waterways.

#### The Goal of This Survey

The Community Pulse Survey is designed to better understand the experiences and priorities of everyone who spends time in Towerside. The feedback will help guide Towerside's priorities, inform public sector decision-making, and influence local development so it reflects the community's voice.

#### Who It's For

This survey is for people who visit, live, or work in and around the Towerside Innovation District, located between Stadium Village, Prospect Park, and the St. Paul Westgate areas along University Avenue.

#### What's Inside

The survey asks about how you experience the neighborhood, including sidewalks, transit, safety, parks, and events. It explores what services and spaces are most important to you, such as housing, small businesses, and community gathering places. It also invites you to share your priorities and vision for the future — from affordable housing and green space to jobs, culture, and connection.
